**NON-FEDERAL SPONSOR:** City of San Antonio, TX

**BACKGROUND:** Olmos Creek is located near the central portion of Bexar County, Texas, approximately 5 miles north of the city of San Antonio's central business district. The study area is located on lands owned by the city of San Antonio and the city of Alamo Heights within the Olmos Basin Reservoir. The reservoir was created by the construction of Olmos Dam which had the sole purpose of flood control. The reservoir basin has begun to attract a variety of recreational facilities, including a city park, skeet range, golf course, baseball fields and other recreational amenities. This has altered a substantial acreage of aquatic, grassland and bottomland forest habitat located within the study area.

<u>STATUS:</u> The recommended plan consists of the restoration of approximately 73 acres of bottomland hardwood habitat, 17 acres of native prairie, and six acres of instream aquatic habitat. The City of San Antonio is ready to sign and Project Agreement and begin project design.

**ISSUES:** Without adequate funding, cannot complete project design or start construction.
