BACKGROUND: This project is located in Pope, Logan, Johnson and Yell Counties of Arkansas. Dardanelle Lock and Dam are located on the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System and the project purposes include hydropower and navigation. The project contains four 35,000 kW hydropower generator units.

<u>STATUS</u>: Current work includes scheduled routine operation and maintenance activities. Additional work consists of channel dredging and lock dewatering.


<u>FY 2012 Scheduled Work</u>: Funds in the amount of \$7,758,000 are being used for scheduled operation and maintenance activities.

<u>FY 2013 Budget</u>: Funds included in the President's FY 2013 budget in the amount of \$8,912,000 will be used for scheduled operation (\$6,380,000) and maintenance (\$2,532,000) activities. Additional funds could be used for seal leaking monolith joints and backup dam gallery pump station (\$1,400,000), replace 4.16kV lock service feeders, dam gallery lighting and receptacles (\$1,000,000), replace dam control wiring (\$250,000), replace overhead lock lighting (\$425,000), boundary monumentation (\$387,000), Old Post Road Modernization – construct 40 campsites loop along with new shower facility (\$750,000) for a total capability of \$13,124,000.
