BACKGROUND: Estelline Springs Area V is located on the Prairie Dog Town Fork of the Red River in Hall County, about one half mile east of Estelline, Texas. The structure is an earthen ring dike, 9 feet high and 340 feet in diameter, constructed around the brine water Estelline Springs. The weight of the water contained by the dike stops the spring from flowing. The dike has stopped about 240 tons of chlorides from entering the Red River each day since it was constructed in 1964.

STATUS: FY 2011 activities included routine scheduled operations and maintenance activities at the project. There were no major maintenance contracts awarded for the Estelline Springs project in FY 2011.
