BACKGROUND: John Redmond Dam and Reservoir is located on the Grand Neosho River at river mile 343.7, about 3 miles northwest of Burlington in Coffey County, Kansas. The project consists of a 21,790 foot long structure made up of an earth-filled embankment and a gated ogee weir, concrete spillway with fourteen 40x35 foot high tainter gates located in the left abutment. The project has more than 130,000 recreation visits each year. At conservation pool the lake covers 8084 acres.

STATUS: FY 2011 activities included routine scheduled operations and maintenance activities at the project. Major maintenance contracts awarded at John Redmond Lake during FY 2011 included construction of a new floating bulkhead and repairs to the Hartford Levee at the upper end of the lake.


