TYPE OF PROJECT: Continuing Authorities Program (CAP)

PROJECT PHASE: Feasibility

CONGRESSIONAL INTEREST: Senators Boozman (AR) and Pryor (AR); Representative Crawford (AR-01)

NON-FEDERAL SPONSOR: City of Oil Trough, AR

BACKGROUND: The city of Oil Trough, Arkansas, is located on the White River in Independence County. The city is concerned with the flooding of several dwellings in this area, including the local fire department and two churches. The city of Oil Trough requested that the Little Rock District conduct a small flood damage reduction study of the city. The high water events of 2008 and 2009 intensified flooding issues at several areas within the city.

STATUS: The project is not funded in FY 2012.

ISSUES: The project is not included in the President's FY 2013 budget. If funds are not received to initiate the feasibility phase, the project will be delayed and the city will continue to experience flood damages in several area.
