AUTHORIZATION: Section 14 of the Flood Control Act of 1946, as amended.

TYPE OF PROJECT: Continuing Authorities Program (CAP)

PROJECT PHASE: Feasibility

CONGRESSIONAL INTEREST: Senators Pryor (AR) and Boozman (AR); Representatives

Griffin (AR-02) and Womack (AR-03)

NON-FEDERAL SPONSOR: Conway County, AR

BACKGROUND: Paw Paw Bend Road is in County of Conway, Arkansas along the Arkansas River. The non-federal sponsor requested assistance with a bank erosion problem by letter dated 15 September 2009. A large amount of bank erosion is encroaching on a county road near its intersection with Arkansas Highway 154. The high water events of 2008 and 2009 have highlighted areas that have experienced significant amount of damage due to these events. The eroding bank is presently less than 50-feet from the road. Rip-rap bank stabilization is needed along the south bank of the Arkansas River. The project benefits would include flood risk management and bank stabilization.

STATUS: Remaining project funds in the amount of \$47,042 were revoked in FY11. The project is not funded in FY 2012. Funding is required to continue the feasibility phase.

<u>ISSUES</u>: The project is not included in the President's FY 2013 budget. Lack of funding to continue the feasibility phase delays providing much needed flood risk management and bank stabilization measures in the project area.

<u>FY 2013 Budget</u>: Project is not included in the President's FY 2013 budget. Funds in the amount of \$77,000 could be used to complete the feasibility phase.

COMPLETION: With optimum funding, the study completion date is 2013.
