TYPE OF PROJECT: Continuing Authorities Program (CAP)

PROJECT PHASE: Feasibility

NON-FEDERAL SPONSOR: City of Paris, AR

BACKGROUND: The City of Paris, Arkansas requested the Little Rock District conduct a small flood damage reduction study for the town of Paris, Arkansas. Several structures along Short Mountain Creek have been experiencing flood damages. Study funds were originally requested in August 2004. The original request was returned in 2007 citing no funds available. The first \$100,000 to initiate a feasibility study is at full Federal expense; any costs beyond the initial \$100,000 require a Feasibility Cost Sharing Agreement and will be cost shared 50/50. Once a Project Partnership Agreement is signed, the project would be cost shared 35/65 (non-federal, federal).

STATUS: The project is not funded in FY 2012.

ISSUES: The project is not included in the President's FY 2013 budget. If funds are not received to initiate the feasibility phase, the project will be delayed and structures along Short Mountain Creek will continue to experience flood damages.
