

BACKGROUND: Table Rock Lake is located in Branson, Missouri and is one of five multiple-purpose projects within the White River Basin. The primary purpose of the lake is power generation. The project contains four 50,000 kW hydropower generator units.

STATUS: Current work includes scheduled routine operation and maintenance activities.

SCHEDULE:

<u>FY 2012 Scheduled Work</u>: Funds in the amount of \$6,943,000 are being used for scheduled operation and maintenance activities.

<u>FY 2013 Budget</u>: Funds included in the President's FY 2013 budget in the amount of \$8,254,000 will be used for scheduled operation (\$5,902,000) and maintenance (\$2,352,000) activities. Additional funds could be used to perform environmental impact study for master and shoreline management plan update (\$330,000), continue update of the project master plan (\$150,000), and perform foundation core and stability analysis (\$500,000), for a total capability of \$9,234,000.
