

BACKGROUND: Hords Creek Lake is located in Coleman County, about 13 miles west of the city of Coleman, Texas. The project was authorized by the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1945. The Central Colorado River Authority is the local sponsor for the water supply storage. The project consists of an earthfill embankment 6,800 feet long (including 500 feet emergency spillway) and 91 feet high, and one 8-foot diameter conduit controlled by two (4-foot x 6-foot) gates. The water supply outlet is one (2-foot) cast iron pipe and the controlled conduit outlet is 8 feet in diameter with two (4-foot x 6-foot) slide gates. Flood control storage is 16,670 acre-feet and water supply storage is 5,684 acre-feet. Three recreation areas comprise 1,215 acres. 2011 visitation totaled 368,006 visitor hours.

STATUS: FY 2011 Activities include routine scheduled O&M; to include repair of hydraulic pumps for flood gates.
