BACKGROUND: Lake Lewisville is located in the southern portion of Denton County, Texas, approximately 25 miles northwest of the city of Dallas. The project area is located on privately owned land along the lower reaches of Hackberry Creek and Stewart Creek on the east side of the lake.

STATUS: On-going. Project Design is scheduled to be completed in FY 12.

ISSUES: Without adequate funding, project construction will not start.
