BACKGROUND: Whitney Lake is located in Hill and Bosque Counties at river mile 442 on the Brazos River, 5.5 miles southwest of the city of Whitney and 35 miles upstream from the city of Waco, Texas. The project was authorized by the Flood Control Acts of 1941 and 1944. The project consists of a concrete gravity, earthfill dam (17,695 feet x 159 feet) and a controlled spillway (680 feet). There are two 15,000 KW power units. Flood control storage capacity is 1,372,400 acre-feet and water supply storage is 248,100 acre-feet. Thirty-four recreational areas comprise 5,438 acres. 2011 visitation totaled 5,021,865 visitor hours.

STATUS: FY 2011 Activities include routine scheduled O&M activities; to include repair of Koperral Levee deficiencies.
