NON-FEDERAL SPONSOR: Fort Bend County

BACKGROUND: The project lies south of the City of Houston along the FM 521 corridor east of Missouri City and west of Pearland. It contains the City of Arcola corporate limits and the Fresno area located to the north of Arcola. There are approximately 4,600 acres in the project area. Currently there is no comprehensive system for water supply with the exception of three small water supply companies. The majority of all water is provided by private water wells. The existing wells produce low quality water. Environmental complaints within the Arcola region generally exceed the total complaints received in the remainder of Fort Bend County. Wastewater treatment is generally accomplished through the use of private septic tanks. Unfortunately, lot sizes are often too small to provide adequate drain field area for a proper functioning system.

STATUS: The project was not funded in FY 2011.

ISSUES: The Fort Bend County Health Department reports serious health concerns resulting from low quality water wells and malfunctioning septic systems in the project area.
