AUTHORIZATION: This project was authorized under the Flood Control Act of 1962.

TYPE OF PROJECT: Flood damage reduction, recreation, water supply, environmental stewardship



PROJECT PHASE: O&M

CONGRESSIONAL INTEREST: Senators Coburn and Inhofe, OK; Representative **Lucas**, OK-3.

BACKGROUND: Kaw Lake is located on the Arkansas River at river mile 653.7, about 8 miles east of Ponca City in Kay County, Oklahoma. The dam is a rolled earth-filled embankment 9466 feet long, including the spillway. The gate-controlled concrete valley spillway is an ogee weir and includes a stilling basin and outlet works. Flow over the spillway is controlled by eight 50x47 feet tainter gates. Low flow facilities consist of two 6x10 foot sluices. At conservation pool the lake covers 16,750 acres.

STATUS: FY 2011 activities included routine scheduled operations and maintenance activities at the project. There were no major maintenance contracts awarded at the project in FY 2011.

ISSUES: Kaw Lake requires additional funding to provide for critical maintenance that cannot be provided through the regular appropriation. Kaw Lake requires additional funds to install a seepage filter blanket on the downstream face of the dam.

PROJECT MAP KAW LAKE, OKLAHOMA

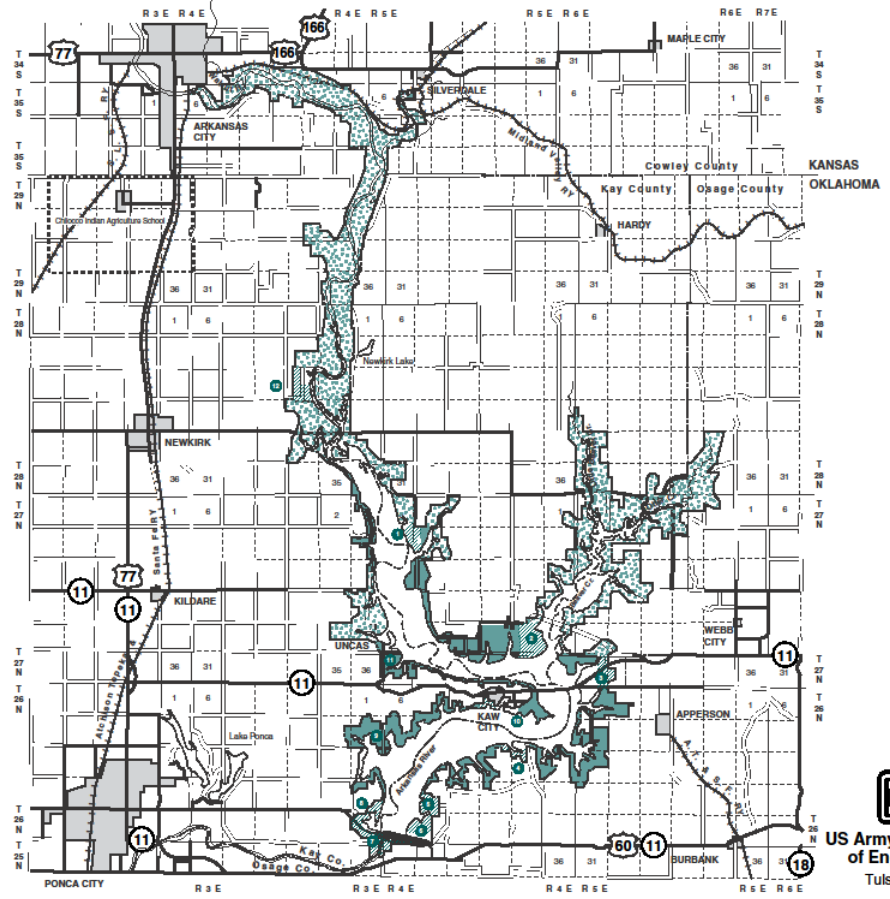
