BACKGROUND: Robert S. Kerr Lock and Dam is located on the Arkansas River at Navigation Mile 336.2, approximately 8 miles south of Sallisaw, in LeFlore County, Oklahoma. The dam is constructed of rolled earth-filled material. The total length of the structure, including the spillway, powerhouse intake, and navigation lock, is 7230 feet. A gated, concrete ogee weir type spillway extends partly across the existing river channel. The spillway weir is surmounted by eighteen 50x44 foot tainter gates. The lock is a single lift, Ohio River type and has a chamber 110 feet wide by 600 feet long with a normal lift of 48 feet. The powerhouse is an integral-type structure with four 27,500-kW Kaplan type units having a total capacity of 110,000 kW.

STATUS: FY 2011 activities included routine scheduled operations and maintenance activities at the project. Major maintenance contracts awarded at the project in FY 2011 included repairs to tainter valves and removal of asbestos in the powerhouse.

<u>ISSUES:</u> Robert S. Kerr Lock and Dam requires additional funding to provide for critical maintenance that cannot be provided through the regular appropriation. Robert S. Kerr Lock and Dam requires additional funds to rehab the tainter gates.


<u>FY 2012 Scheduled Work:</u> The current FY 2012 budget will be used for routine operations and maintenance activities at the project.
