BACKGROUND: Joe Pool Lake is located in Dallas, Tarrant and Ellis counties, about 10 miles southwest of the city of Dallas, Texas. The project was authorized by the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1945. The Trinity River Authority is the local sponsor for water supply storage. The project consists of an earthfill dam 108.5 feet high, 24,200 feet long, with uncontrolled concrete spillway 50 feet long creating lake with total storage capacity of 304,500 acre-feet (flood control 127,200 acre-feet; water supply 142,900 acre-feet; sediment reserve 38,000 acre-feet). There are five recreation areas with 3,730 acres. 2011 visitation totaled 7,211,732 visitor hours.

STATUS: FY 2011 activities included routine scheduled O&M activities.
