NON-FEDERAL SPONSOR: Franklin County Water District

BACKGROUND: Lake Austin is located on the Lower Colorado River within the city limits of Austin, Texas. The lake was formed by construction of Tom Miller Dam by the Lower Colorado River Authority in 1939.

STATUS: Franklin County Water District requested assistance of the Corps of Engineers under Section 206 authority to address aquatic ecosystem degradation in Lake Cypress Springs.

ISSUES: Congress has decreed that there will be no new starts for Section 206 studies in Fiscal Year 2011.
