TYPE OF PROJECT: Continuing Authority Program – Section 206

PROJECT PHASE: Feasibility



CONGRESSIONAL INTEREST: Senators Hutchison and Cornyn (TX); Representative **Johnson (TX-30)**

NON-FEDERAL SPONSOR: City of Dallas, TX

BACKGROUND: White Rock Lake is located approximately 4 miles east of downtown Dallas, Texas. The study limits would extend downstream from the lake, past Interstate Highway 30 and Scyene Road (Highway 352), to approximately 2nd Avenue. The length of this reach is approximately four miles.

STATUS: The city of Dallas has requested assistance of the Corps of Engineers under Section 206 authority to address aquatic ecosystem degradation in and along Lower White Rock Creek.

ISSUES: Congress has decreed that there will be no new starts for Section 206 studies in Fiscal Year 2012.
