BACKGROUND: The city of San Marcos is located in south central Texas in Hays County, approximately 30 miles southwest of Austin, Texas. The proposed restoration area is located along and within the San Marcos River and associated riparian corridor that extends from the footbridge below City Park downstream to the confluence with the Guadalupe River.

STATUS: The study team is in the process of documenting existing and future without project conditions.

ISSUES: Without adequate funding, cannot draft, negotiate, or execute a PPA and fund project design.
